Appointment of Franck Goldnadel as President of Europe (except UK)

In 2010, he takes over the management of Paris-Orly Airport (28 million passengers), before being entrusted with the position of Director of Paris-Charles de Gaulle Airport (70 million passengers) in 2011 In parallel, from 2014 to 2018, Franck Goldnadel took over the role of Deputy Director General in charge of airport operations at Groupe Aéroports de Paris in order to pilot the strategy of the Ile-de-France airport system.

These different professional experiences have enabled him to develop a solid experience in development, management, team management and customer service. Franck Goldnadel graduated from the National School of Civil Aviation in 1993. He is an Officer of the French National Order of Merit.
